1	[Provide primary scientific oversight and coordination for ongoing AIDS research studies in		
2	Africa.]

4	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office,		
5	(SFDPH,AIDS) to enter retroactively into an agreement with The Regents of the		
6	University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, to accept and		
7	expend funds in the amount of \$10,623 to participate in AIDS prevention studies in		
8	Africa, for the period of March 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002.

10	WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and		
11	Human Services, National Institutes of Health, for the conduct of a program entitled		
12	"International Traineeships in AIDS Prevention Studies (ITAPS)" and,		
13	WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCSF, and SFDPH, AIDS to		
14	participate in this program; and,		
15	WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$10,623 from this		
16	award; and,		
17	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH, AIDS to		
18	enter into a subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
19	Board of Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
20	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
21	WHEREAS, The terms of the Agreement prohibit including indirect costs in the grant		
22	budget; now, therefore, be it		
23	RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a		
24	subcontract agreement in the amount of \$10,623 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for

1	services under the "International Traineeships in AIDS Prevention Studies (ITAPS)" program;		
2	and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of		
4	indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
6	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded		
8	under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the		
9	agreement expires.
