Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding Section 32.6.35, to read as follows:

Sec. 32.6.35. No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, on the south side of Vallejo Street, from Powell Street to 94 feet easterly, and from Churchill Street to 106 feet easterly, and on the north side of Vallejo Street, from Powell Street to 78 feet easterly, and from Emery Lane to 64 feet easterly, except for marked police vehicles. Violation of this Section is an obstruction to the free use of property and a nuisance within the meaning of Division 4, Part III of the Civil Code of California relating to nuisance and the abatement thereof.

Any vehicle found in violation of this Section shall be subject to removal by towaway at the owner's expense under the provisions of Section 22651(n) of the Vehicle Code of the State of California.
