WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services owns a building at 150 Otis; and, WHEREAS, The building can only be used for storage because it is seismically unsafe to use for any other reason; and,

WHEREAS, Eight floors of 150 Otis are used by the Department of Human Services for the storage of furniture and other equipment; and,

WHEREAS, The first floor is used for the storage of property of homeless people; and, WHEREAS, The first floor of 150 Otis street no longer has any space remaining for homeless people to store property; and,

WHEREAS, The second and third floor could be used for additional storage space for the property of homeless people without the Department of Human Services being unduly impacted in regards to the storage of furniture and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, The Mayors Office of Homelessness estimates that there are between 11,000 and 14,000 homeless people in San Francisco on any given night; and,

WHEREAS, 150 Otis is located very close to the center of the city making it easier for homeless people to access their property; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of Human Services increase the amount of floors used for the storage of homeless person's property at 150 Otis Street from one to three.
