

1 [Electronic Reports of Campaign Contributions.]

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3 **Ordinance adding section 1.112.5 to Article I, Chapter 1 of the Campaign and**
4 **Governmental Conduct Code to require electronic disclosure of campaign**
5 **contributions received by candidates for City Elective Office during the final forty-five**
6 **days before an election at which the candidate's name will appear on the ballot.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code is hereby
12 amended by adding Section 1.112.5, to read as follows:

13 **SEC. 1.112.5. ELECTRONIC REPORTS OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS**

14 *(a) Disclosure Requirement. Within 45 days of an election, any candidate for City elective*
15 *office whose name will appear on the ballot at that election and who has received \$1,000 in campaign*
16 *contributions, shall file an electronic report with the Ethics Commission within 24 hours of receiving a*
17 *campaign contribution of \$100 or more disclosing:*

18 *(1) The total amount of the contribution; and*

19 *(2) The contributor's full name, street address, occupation, employer, or, if self-employed,*
20 *the name of the contributor's business.*

21 *(b) Format. The disclosure requirement imposed by subsection (a) shall not apply until the*
22 *Ethics Commission has prescribed a format for the electronic reports required by that subsection. The*
23 *Ethics Commission shall prescribe an electronic format for reports required by subsection (a) within*
24 *90 days of the effective date of this section.*
