3 **Resolution declaring June 19 as Health Care National Day of Action in San Francisco.**

5 WHEREAS, nearly 44 million people - 8.5 million of them children - have no healthcare
6 and 8 out of 10 of the uninsured are from working families; and

7 WHEREAS, every minute 5 Americans lose their health coverage and by this time
8 tomorrow, 7,000 more Americans will have lost their healthcare; and,

9 WHEREAS, quality, affordable health care that Americans once were able to rely upon
10 is quickly being priced out of reach for millions of hardworking, taxpaying Americans; and,

11 WHEREAS, in 2003, almost 7 Million Californian residents were without health
12 insurance for the entire year; and

13 WHEREAS, 53 percent of uninsured Californians are members of a family in which at
14 least one person works full time; now therefore be it,

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
16 hereby declares that Saturday, June 19, is Health Care National Day of Action in San
17 Francisco; and be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors commends the Service Employees
19 International Union, and other sponsors of the Health Care National Day of Action, an event
20 that spans the nation from the Golden Gate Bridge to the Brooklyn Bridge, for working to
21 achieve quality, affordable health care for all.
