Resolution urging the U.S. Congress to allocate \$4.3 billion in funding for the fiscal year 2007 Community Development Block Grant Program.

WHEREAS, The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program was enacted, and signed into law by President Gerald Ford, as the centerpiece of the Title I, Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and,

WHEREAS, The CDBG program has helped to create and sustain viable urban communities, by providing funding for services and affordable housing and expanding economic opportunities for persons of low and moderate income; and,

WHEREAS, The CDBG program has considerable flexibility to allow communities to carry out activities that are tailored to their unique affordable housing and neighborhood revitalization needs; and,

WHEREAS, Throughout its 32-year history, the CDBG program has been a successful partnership among the federal, state and local governments, and the business and nonprofit sectors which carry out activities that improve the lives and neighborhoods of low and moderate income families; and,

WHEREAS, Each year the Mayor's Office of Community Development prepares an application and proposals for the acceptance and expenditure of CDBG funds on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco will receive \$21,869,337 in CDBG funds in fiscal year 2006, a reduction of 9.4% from fiscal year 2005, to support essential activities, such as housing rehabilitation, public space improvements, public services and economic development projects that primarily benefit our low and moderate income residents and communities; and,

WHEREAS, Should such a proposal be enacted, it would have a devastating effect on San Francisco, reducing the City's CDBG allocation to \$16,402,000, resulting in a cumulative reduction of 36.5% since 2001, and the elimination of many essential services and supports to our most fragile residents and communities; now, therefore, be it

federal budget allocation of \$4.3 billion for the Community Development Block Grant Program
