As mentioned above, this adult sports club has been in existence since 1873. Part of the club's traditions involve the incidental consumption of alcoholic beverages following club sporting events. The social fabric of the club is also enhanced via social hours that occur every other Friday after work. The sporting events and social hours are open to club members and their guests and not the general public.

Club tradition also includes the celebration of certain occasions of the annual calendar (St Patrick's Day, Gay Pride, Winter Holidays, etc). Alcohol is typically served at those events.

Before COVID, we rented the club out approximately 3 to 5 times per year for weddings, memorials and the like. It would be common for these rentals to include an alcoholic toast.

Under no circumstances is alcohol served at the club taken off premise.
