

1 [Port Security Services Civil Service Exclusion.]

3 **Resolution approving the Controller's certification that Port Area Security Services for**
4 **the Port of San Francisco can be practically performed by a private contractor at a**
5 **lower cost than if the work were performed by City employees at budgeted levels.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco Charter Section 10.104.15 provides that positions
8 determined by the Controller and approved by the Board of Supervisors to be positions where
9 the work or services can be practically performed under private contract at a lesser cost than
10 similar work performed by employees of the City and County may be exempt from Civil
11 Service selection, appointment and removal procedures; and

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Port Commission has obtained a determination by the
13 Controller that the requirements of Charter Section 10.104.15 have been satisfied with the
14 Controller's finding that the proposed Port area security services can be practically performed
15 by a private contract at a lesser cost than similar work performed by City and County
16 employees; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Port security services contract would comply with all applicable City
18 ordinances and regulations pertaining to service contracts, and the work is not required to be
19 performed by officers or employees of the City and County under the provisions of the Charter
20 or other applicable law; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the determination of the
22 Controller that Port area security services can be performed by private contract under an
23 exclusion from civil service appointment pursuant to Charter Section 10.104.15.
