RESOLVED, That CHN, LHH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a contract agreement with STANFORD, the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$5,000 for services under the "Grants for Geriatric Education Centers" project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City.
