

1 [Revolving Fund Agreement - California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board
2 - Burial or Emergency Relocation of Homicide Victims - \$75,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to renew its**
4 **current agreement with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims**
5 **Board, an agent of the State of California, for a revolving fund in the amount of**
6 **\$75,000 to be used to pay for verified funeral/burial, relocation, crime scene clean-up,**
7 **and other emergency loss expenses for eligible homicide victims for the period of**
8 **July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017.**

10 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to enter into an
11 agreement with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board in
12 accordance with Government Section 13835 to provide a means to pay for verified
13 funeral/burial, relocation, crime scene clean-up, and other emergency loss expenses for
14 eligible homicide victims, and to be reimbursed by the State thereafter; and

15 WHEREAS, This agreement would authorize the District Attorney's Victim Witness
16 Assistance Program to pay verified funeral/burial, relocation, crime scene clean-up, and
17 other emergency loss expenses for eligible homicide victims out of the revolving fund; and

18 WHEREAS, The fund maintains a process by which the District Attorney may make
19 speedy payments to service providers and increase service to victims; and

20 WHEREAS, Funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that
21 would, in the absence of California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board
22 Programs, be made available to support the assistance of victims of crime; and


23 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and


24 WHEREAS, No indirect costs are included by the Department to maximize the value
25 of the service; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs
2 in the grant budget; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San
4 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to contract for,
5 accept and expend funds from the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims
6 Board to continue the Revolving Fund Agreement, including any extensions, augmentations
7 or amendments thereof.
