12 WHEREAS, The idea for 'An Evening of Kung Pao Kosher Comedy' came to
13 Lisa Geduldig while she was performing comedy at the Peking Garden Club near
14 Northampton, Massachusetts when she suddenly felt that, by telling Jewish jokes in a
15 Chinese restaurant, she had reached the pinnacle of her career as a Jewish comic; and

17 WHEREAS, The concept for 'An Evening of Kung Pao Kosher Comedy' expands
18 on, and refines, the New York Jewish tradition on Christmas of making an annual
19 family pilgrimage to a Chinese restaurant and then to a movie; and

21 WHEREAS, 'An Evening of Kung Pao Kosher Comedy' provides a unique
22 Christmas experience, offering a celebration of Jewish culture and a sense of community
23 to an audience that ranges from the Birnbaums of Walnut Creek to the all-American
24 Jewish gay couple in the Castro, and also includes many non-Jews; and




