

1 [Appointments, Sunshine Ordinance Task Force - Victoria Baranetsky and Eric Eldon]

3 **Motion appointing Victoria Baranetsky (residency requirement waived) and**
4 **reappointing Eric Eldon (residency requirement waived), terms ending April 27, 2018, to**
5 **the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.**

7 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
8 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Sunshine
9 Ordinance Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 67.30, for
10 the terms specified:

11 Victoria Baranetsky (residency requirement waived), seat 1, succeeding Mark Rumold,
12 term expired, must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional
13 Journalists and be an attorney, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27,
14 2018.

15 Eric Eldon (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding themselves, term expired,
16 must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists and be a
17 local journalist, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27, 2018.

18 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 19 1. The membership of the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has a goal to be
20 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 21 2. Applicants Victoria Baranetsky and Eric Eldon, who are not residents of San Francisco,
22 are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Sunshine
23 Ordinance Task Force.
- 24 3. The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has attempted to fill the positions, for Victoria
25 Baranetsky and Eric Eldon were nominated, with individuals who are City residents and

1 who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but have been unable to do
2 so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Victoria Baranetsky and Eric
3 Eldon are qualified to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.

- 4 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no
5 other possible representatives, who are residents of San Francisco, and who have the
6 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who
7 are willing to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force at this time; and, be it

8 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
9 for Victoria Baranetsky and Eric Eldon, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident,
10 willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires
11 person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative
12 act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
