AT&T Corporation, et al.</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-582552, with respect to AT&T Corp. and Pacific Bell Telephone Company (collectively, "AT&T"), by AT&T's payment of \$15,400,000, AT&T's agreement to collect and remit access line taxes in a certain manner in the future unless there is a material change in the law, and mutual releases for past conduct and access line tax liability. The lawsuit involves allegations that the defendants knowingly under-collected and under-remitted amounts due under the Access Line Tax Ordinance in violation of the California False Claims Act.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on January 29, 2020, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiff-Relator Roger Schneider; Real Party in Interest City and County of San Francisco; Defendants AT&T Corporation; Pacific Bell Telephone Company; U.S. Telepacific Corp., dba TPx Communications; MCI Communications Services LLC; MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC; Verizon Business Network Services LLC; and XO Communications Services, LLC.
