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3 **Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by amending the title to**
4 **Chapter 2A, Article 1 to add the Department of Administrative Services and by adding a**
5 **new Section 2A.22 to Chapter 2A, Article 1 to create the Mayor’s Office on Disability**
6 **and place it within the Department of Administrative Services and empower the**
7 **Mayor’s Office on Disability to issue, subject to approval by ordinance of the Board of**
8 **Supervisors, policies and procedures with respect to compliance with the Americans**
9 **with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336) and other disability rights laws and disability**
10 **access regulations and codes.**

14 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

15 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
16 the title to Chapter 2A, Article 1 to read as follows:

17 Article I: Mayor; City Administrator; Department of Administrative Services; Controller

18 Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding a
19 new Section 2A.22 to Chapter 2A, Article 1 to read as follows:

20 Sec. 2A.22 Department of Administrative Services – Mayor’s Office on Disability

21 (A) There is hereby created within the Department of Administrative Services a Mayor’s
22 Office on Disability. The Mayor’s Office on Disability shall assist City departments in making all
23 programs, services, benefits, activities, and facilities owned, operated, or funded by the City and
24 County of San Francisco accessible to and useable by individuals with disabilities, as may be required

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1 by the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336) and other disability rights laws and
2 disability access regulations and codes.

3 (B) The Mayor's Office on Disability may issue policies and procedures with respect to
4 compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336) and other disability rights
5 laws and disability access regulations and codes. The Mayor's Office on Disability may, at its
6 discretion, consult with City departments on the development of these policies and procedures. Such
7 policies and procedures shall be subject to approval by ordinance of the Board of Supervisors and
8 upon approval shall be binding on all City departments.
