11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	
13	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 10.100-106 to read as
14	follows:
15	
16	SEC. 10.100-106. MAYOR'S FUND FOR THE HOMELESS.
17	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Mayor's Fund for the Homeless is established as a category six fund
18	to receive all donations which may from time to time be received by the City and County of San Francisco for
19	providing shelter, food and other assistance for the homeless.
20	(b) Use of the Fund. The fund is to be used exclusively for the purpose of providing food, shelter and
21	supportive services to the homeless and for costs incurred for promotion of the fund. Funds which are donated
22	for a specific project for the homeless shall be expended only for that project.
23	(c) Administration of Fund. The director of the <i>Human Services Agency Mayor's Office</i>
24	of Housing Opportunities, Partnerships and Engagement (HOPE), or his designee, is authorized to administer the
25	Mayor's Fund for the Homeless and to determine expenditures from the fund, in keeping with the original

1	intended uses of the fund. The director or his designee shall report regularly to the Human Services
2	Commission City's Local Homeless Coordinating Board on gifts to and expenditures from the fund, at such time as all
3	expenditures from the department's gifts fund are reported upon.
4	
5	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment
6	occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the
7	ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
8	
9	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend
10	only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts,
11	diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as
12	additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note"
13	that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
