Resolution authorizing designated City and County officials to execute and file, on
behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, any actions necessary for the purpose
of obtaining State and Federal financial assistance under various grant programs,
including: the FY2014 Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant, the FY2014 State

Homeland Security Grant Program, the FY2014 Emergency Management Performance

Grant, and the 2014 Local Government Oil Spill Contingency Plan Grant Program.

WHEREAS, The State of California, through various homeland security grant programs, provides support for the development and maintenance of the capability of local jurisdictions to prepare for and respond to natural disasters, acts of terrorism, and other manmade disasters, as well as disperses federal funds provided for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, The State of California's Department of Fish and Game provides support for oil spill response planning; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has participated in these programs since their inception and deems them vital to the continued well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, The State of California requires that applicant's agents be named in the resolution, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management; or in his or her absence, the Chief Financial Officer, the Deputy Director, or the Assistant Deputy Director of the Department of Emergency Management; or the General Manager, Assistant General Manager, or Chief Financial Officer of the Bay Area UASI program, to execute for and on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a public entity established under the laws of

1	the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining state and federal
2	financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-
3	granted through the State of California, as well as provided directly by the State of California,
4	including: the FY2014 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant, the FY2014 State
5	Homeland Security Grant Program, the FY2014 Emergency Management Performance Grant
6	and the 2014 Local Government Oil Spill Contingency Plan Grant Program.
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
