24 county to adopt ordinances regulating zoning within its jurisdiction; and

1           WHEREAS, Existing law authorizes a licensed beer manufacturer, a licensed  
2 winegrower, and any on-sale licensee to sell certain alcoholic beverages for consumption on  
3 or off the premises, as specified; and

4           WHEREAS, SB 793 would authorize a licensed beer manufacturer, a licensed  
5 winegrower, and any on-sale licensee to permit consumers to leave the premises with open  
6 containers of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises within an entertainment  
7 zone, subject to certain conditions; and

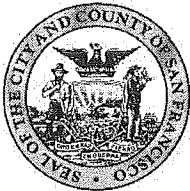
8           WHEREAS, SB 793 would define "entertainment zone" for purposes of the Alcoholic  
9 Beverage Control Act as a zone created by a city, county, or city and county ordinance on or  
10 after January 1, 2023, that authorizes consumption of one or more types of alcoholic  
11 beverages on public streets, sidewalks, or public rights-of-way in that zone; and

12           WHEREAS, On January 12, 2022, SB 793 passed the Senate with a unanimous 32-0  
13 vote; now, therefore, be it

14           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors supports California Senate Bill No. 793;  
15 and, be it

16           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the  
17 Board to transmit a copy of this Resolution to San Francisco's state legislative delegation, the  
18 Office of the Chief Clerk of the Assembly, and the Office of Governor Newsom.
