APPOINTING FOUR MEMBERS TO THE CHILD CARE PLANNING AND ADVISORY COUNCIL; WAIVING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council, pursuant to the provisions of San Francisco Administrative Code, Section 5.200, and California Education Code, Sections 8499-8499.8, for the terms specified:

Terry Cronan, succeeding Nathaniel Mason, (Seat No. 5, Must be nominee of Supervisor Newsom and represent a Head Start Center), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

September Jarrett, succeeding Lisa Quan, (Seat No. 8, Must be nominee of Supervisor Teng and represent a community organization), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002:

Byron Sigal, succeeding himself, (Seat No. 10, Must be nominee of Supervisor Ammiano and represent local business), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

Margaret Jerene, succeeding Dolores Velazquez, (Seat No. 11, Must be nominee Supervisor Leno and represent a community organization), for a new three-year term ending April 1, 2002;

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- Applicant Terry Cronan, an appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a
 person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Child Care
 Planning and Advisory Council.
- 3. The Child Care Planning and Advisory Council has attempted to fill the position, for which Terry Cronan was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Terry Cronan is qualified to serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Child Care Planning and Advisory Council at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Terry Cronan, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires persons appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be residents of the City and County of San Francisco.
