RESOLUTION NO. 26-0101

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) seeks to retain the services of qualified consultants to supplement and augment SFPUC staff and provide environmental services on an as-needed basis to support Water, Wastewater, and Power Enterprise capital projects; and

WHEREAS, The services of these qualified environmental consultants are necessary to provide specialized environmental analyses documents pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), resource agency permit documents, environmental construction compliance services, or other environmentally related specialized services to supplement SFPUC staff to support Water, Wastewater, and Power capital projects; and

WHEREAS, The estimated cost of services is not-to-exceed \$15,000,000 per contract; and

WHEREAS, On November 21, 2025, the SFPUC advertised a Request for Proposals for As-Needed Environmental Review Services, received seven proposals, and recommends award to the five highest-ranked proposers; and

WHEREAS, Services are anticipated to begin in August 2026 and end in August 2033 and the duration of this contract is seven years; and

WHEREAS, SFPUC and Contract Monitoring Division (CMD) staff, upon review of the proposal scores, determined that Environmental Science Associates, Inc. (ESA), AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM), Panorama Environmental, Inc. (Panorama), GEI Consultants, Inc. (GEI), and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (Stantec) are the five highest-ranked firms based on the established scoring criteria; and

WHEREAS, The CMD established a 20% Local Business Enterprise (LBE) subconsultant participation requirement for this contract and ESA, AECOM, Panorama, GEI, and Stantec each committed to an LBE subconsultant participation of 20% with their respective proposals; and


WHEREAS, This action does not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15378 because it will not result in a physical change in the environment, and this action is not an approval of any specific project; and

WHEREAS, Staff will not initiate support services during construction until any necessary environmental review under the CEQA has been completed; and

WHEREAS, Funds for Contract Nos. PRO.0333.A-E, As-Needed Environmental Review Services, will be available from the Water Enterprise, Wastewater Enterprise, and Power Enterprise operating and capital budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby awards Contract Nos. PRO.0333.A-E, As-Needed Environmental Review Services, to Environmental Science Associates, Inc. (PRO.0333.A), AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (PRO.0333.B); Panorama Environmental, Inc. (PRO.0333.C), GEI Consultants, Inc. (PRO.0333.D); and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (PRO.0333.E), to provide as-needed environmental review services, each for an amount not-to-exceed \$15,000,000, and with a duration of seven years, all subject to the Board of Supervisors approval under Charter Section 9.118.
