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3 **Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend grant funds made available through the State Office of**
5 **Emergency Services for a project entitled "Law Enforcement Specialized Unit (LESU) –**
6 **Violence Against Women Program," and agreeing to accept an in-kind match from La**
7 **Casa De Las Madres for a Victim Advocate position, and waiving indirect costs due to**
8 **funding constraints.**

10 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco desires to
11 undertake a certain project designated LESU – Violence Against Women, to be funded in part
12 from funds made available through the State Office of Emergency Services; and,
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14 WHEREAS, La Casa De Las Madres agrees to provide an in-kind match to fund a
15 Victim Advocate position. This Victim Advocate will partner with the Domestic Violence
16 inspector to deliver services to women who have been victims of severe and/or repeated
17 domestic violence; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds
19 on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore,
20 be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
22 the grant budget; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
24 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively


1 accept and expend continued funding for this project from the State Office of Emergency

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That The Chief of Police of the City and County of san
4 Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the
5 necessary Grant Agreement for this project including any extensions, funding augmentations
6 from the State Office of Emergency Services or amendments thereof; and be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the
8 performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
9 responsibility of the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
11 supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors, thus the position vacated
12 through this program will be backfilled contemporaneously with the same level of local funding
13 by transferring an equal sum from the Police Department's uniform salary account to its
14 uniform overtime account for that fiscal year.


