Attached please find an original and two copies of a proposed resolution for the approval of the Board of Supervisors, which authorizes the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to submit an application to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for the **Integrated HIV Surveillance and Prevention Programs for Health Departments** grant. This application represents approximately \$7,257,408 in HIV prevention & surveillance funding for San Francisco for calendar year 2018.

This resolution is required by Ordinance No. 265-05, which amends Section 10-170 of the Administrative Code to require Board of Supervisors review of recurring grant applications of \$5,000,000 or more prior to their submission. SFDPH received from CDC the application guidance on June 28, 2017. The application deadline is September 13, 2017.
