1 [Settlement of Lawsuit - Guillermo Chavez - \$30,000]

2
3 Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Guillermo Chavez against the
4 City and County of San Francisco for \$30,000; the lawsuit was filed on October 2, 2009,
5 in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. 439-130; entitled Guillermo Chavez v. City
6 and County of San Francisco, et al.; other material terms of said settlement are: 1)
7 \$10,000 to be paid to the San Francisco Tax Collector's Bureau of Delinquent Revenue
8 to satisfy the medical lien for treatment in this case; 2) \$11,555 to be allocated to
9 attorney's fees and litigation costs; 3) the balance of \$8,445 is to be paid to the Bureau
10 of Delinquent Revenue to pay down money owed by plaintiff to the City for medical
11 treatment unrelated to the injuries in the lawsuit.

13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the action entitled Guillermo
15 Chavez v. City and County of San Francisco, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Court No.
16 439-130 by the payment of \$30,000. The \$30,000 payment is to be allocated as follows: 1)
17 \$10,000 to be paid to the San Francisco Tax Collector's Bureau of Delinquent Revenue to
18 satisfy the medical lien for treatment in this case; 2) \$11,555 to be allocated to attorney's fees
19 and litigation costs; 3) the balance of \$8,445 is to be paid to the Bureau of Delinquent
20 Revenue to pay down money owed by plaintiff to the City for medical treatment unrelated to
21 the injuries in the lawsuit.

1 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on
2 October 2, 2009, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiff Guillermo
3 Chavez and Defendant City and County of San Francisco.

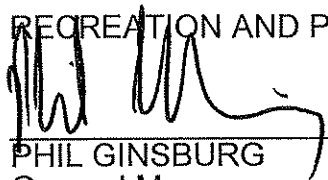

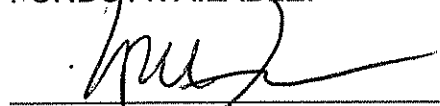

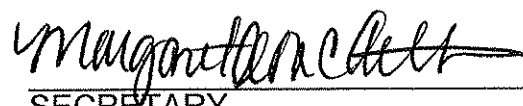
