

1 [Extending Time for Negotiations]

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3 **Motion extending time for negotiations pursuant to Charter Section 11.100**

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5 WHEREAS, The City has been meeting and conferring with its unrepresented  
6 employees over negotiable terms and conditions of employment to take effect July 1, 2002;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, The City has been meeting and conferring with some of its unions in  
9 accordance with provisions in their respective labor agreements over amendments and  
10 modifications to those labor agreements; and

11 WHEREAS, In order to be included in the budget to take effect July 1, 2002 an  
12 agreement or arbitration award must be adopted by ordinance within timelines set forth in  
13 Charter Section A8.409-4, as may be extended by Charter Section 11.100; and

14 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors previously clarified such deadlines in Resolution  
15 No. 91-97; and

16 WHEREAS, Under Charter Section A8.409-4 the Human Resources Director has  
17 requested that the Board of Supervisors take action pursuant to Charter Section 11.100 to  
18 extend by thirty days the date for final adoption of ordinances approving such salary and  
19 benefits; now therefore, be it

20 MOVED, That the date for final adoption of ordinances implementing or modifying  
21 salary, benefits, and/or working conditions to be effective July 1, 2002 is hereby extended by  
22 thirty days. For unions and unrepresented employees in negotiations for which impasse has  
23 not been declared, the date for final adoption of ordinances approving salary, benefits, and/or  
24 working conditions to be effective July 1, 2002 is May 1, 2002. Such proposed collective  
25 bargaining agreements must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board on or about March 27<sup>th</sup>,

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1 2002 in a form that will allow for complete review and costing in time for final adoption by May  
2 1, 2002; and be it

3 FURTHER MOVED, That Arbitration panel awards issued pursuant to Charter Section  
4 A8.409-3 shall be submitted to the Clerk of the Board on or about May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2002 in a form  
5 that will allow for complete review and costing in time for final adoption by June 30, 2002.
