3 **Ordinance amending Article 1, Section 41.25 of the San Francisco Health Code by**
4 **increasing penalties imposed for failing to license a dog or obtain a young dog**
5 **certificate from not less than \$25 nor more than \$50 to exactly \$100; and making**
6 **environmental findings.**

11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12 Section 1. Article 1, Section 41.25 of the San Francisco Health Code is hereby
13 amended to read as follows:

14 **SEC. 41.25. PENALTIES.**

15 (a) ~~Any person violating~~ violation of the provisions of Section 41.21 of this Article shall
16 be ~~deemed guilty of~~ a misdemeanor, and ~~upon conviction thereof shall be~~ punishable by a fine of
17 not more than \$500.

18 (b) ~~Any person violating~~ violation of the provisions of Section 41.15, ~~41.18(e)~~ or 41.19
19 of this Article shall be ~~deemed guilty of~~ an infraction and ~~upon conviction thereof shall be~~
20 punishable by a fine of ~~not less than \$25 nor more than \$50~~ 100.

21 Section 2. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
22 this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California
23 Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of
24 the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and is incorporated herein by reference.
