RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby declares May 15, 2025, as Bike to Wherever Day in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board encourages all residents to participate in Bike to Wherever Day activities, explore the city's bicycle infrastructure, and consider incorporating bicycling into their daily routines.
