

1 [Accept-Expend Private Grant – Back on Track Program]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of**
5 **\$52,355.57 through the San Francisco Foundation, for a program entitled “Back on**
6 **Track Re-entry Program” for fiscal years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to establish a certain
9 project designated the Back on Track Re-entry Program to be funded in part from funds made
10 available through the San Francisco Foundation; and

11 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

12 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
13 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of
15 the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend funds from the San Francisco
16 Foundation for the purposes of re-entry program purposes; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
18 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
20 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for re-entry
21 program purposes, including any extensions, augmentations or amendments thereof; and be
22 it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
24 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all
25 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the

1 purpose of securing Re-entry Program grant funds and to implement and carry out the
2 purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
4 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
5 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and that the grant recipient and the authorizing
6 agency will hold the San Francisco Foundation harmless from any claims that may arise from
7 the use of grant funds.
