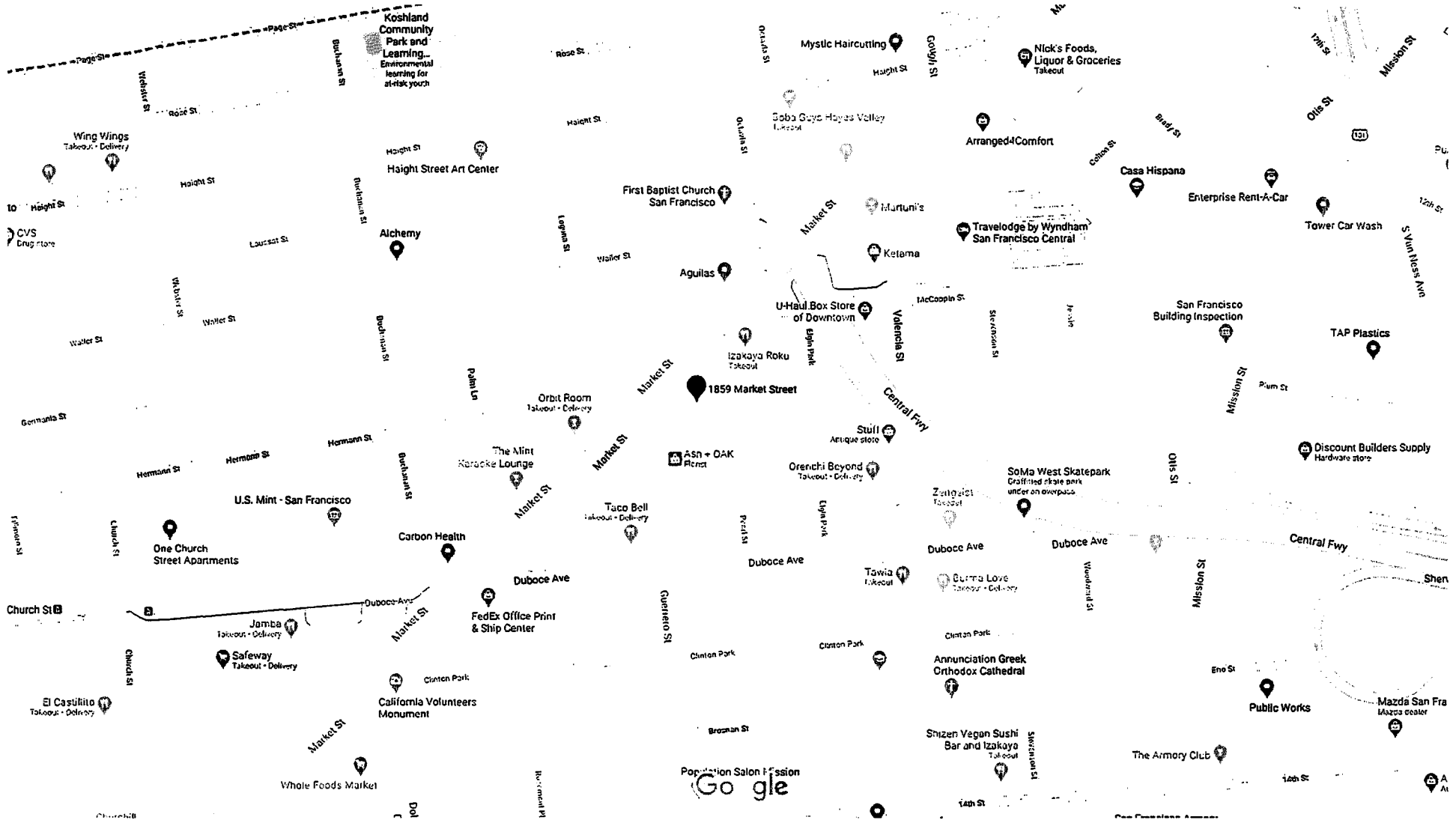
**Conditions for Type 21 - Off Sale General**

1. Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. each day of the week.
2. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml is strictly prohibited.
3. Beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 oz. or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.
4. Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on ABC-253.
