4 CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ~~RETROACTIVELY~~ APPLY FOR, ACCEPT  
5 AND EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$625,000 AVAILABLE THROUGH THE  
6 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR (DOL) EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ADMINISTRATION  
7 (ETA) FOR A MISSION DISTRICT BASED SCHOOL-TO-CAREER PROGRAM.

10 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco has developed a School-to-Career  
11 program located in the Mission District, a federally designated Enterprise Community; and

12 WHEREAS, where one third of the students in this neighborhood are English language  
13 learners, half come from low income families, and 87 percent are minority; and

14 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco, through the School to Career  
15 Partnership, has an infrastructure that connects students, employers, parents, labor, community-  
16 based organizations and schools; and

18 WHEREAS, this project will directly benefit approximately 800 at-risk students and out  
19 of school youth by making stronger connections between the existing School-to-Career program  
20 and Mission District schools; now,

21 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor’s Office of Community Development  
22 is authorized ~~retroactively~~ to submit the attached proposal to the U.S. Department of Labor and  
23 is further authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco the  
24 attached Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or amendments thereof except as any



amendment would increase any hard matching fund obligations of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to the contract; and






