[Accept and Expend Supplemental Grant funds for the Juvenile Probation Department from the California Board of Correction]

Resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer for the Juvenile Probation Department to accept and expend a supplemental grant in the amount of Four Hundred eighty-three thousand seven hundred fifty two dollars (\$483,752), from the State of California Board of Corrections for the Repeat Offender Prevention Program.

WHEREAS, The State Budget Act of 1996-97 established the funding for the Repeat Offender Prevention Program under the authority of the State Board of Corrections; and,

WHEREAS, The Welfare and Institution Code Section 743 through 749 was amended in September 1998 to include San Francisco as a participant county in the Repeat Offender Prevention Program to support local prevention efforts in a community-based setting for youth and their families; and,

WHEREAS, The Juvenile Probation Department intends to use these Repeat Offender Prevention Program grant funds to continue to fund the Robeson/Rivera Academy Project aimed at youth who are at the highest risk of becoming repeat offenders, while on probation for the first time; and,

2 WHEREAS, The Robeson/Rivera Academy Project consists of four
3 basic components: Youth and family focus; Multi-disciplinary team
4 assessment; Formal case and service planning; and Wraparound
5 services; and,

6 WHEREAS, The Juvenile Probation Department has been awarded a
7 supplemental grant in the amount of \$483,752, bringing the total amount
8 of the grant to \$981,254 for the period of June 15, 1999, through June 30,
9 2002: now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
12 Chief Probation Officer for the Juvenile Probation Department to accept
13 and expend grant funds in the amount of \$483,752 from the State Board
14 of Corrections to provide services to youth who are at highest risk of
15 becoming repeat offenders and their families; and, be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Juvenile Probation Department will
18 adhere to the requirements and conditions specified in the grant from the
19 State Board of Corrections.






