5 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio was born in 1914 in Martinez  
6 California; and,

7 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio was raised from the age of one  
8 within San Francisco's North Beach district; and,

9 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio lived in a flat at Valparaiso and  
10 Taylor Streets; and,

11 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio started his professional career in  
12 the Pacific Coast League with the San Francisco Seals; and,

13 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio had the longest consecutive  
14 professional hitting streak of 61 for the San Francisco Seals in  
15 1933; and,

16 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio led the American League with 15  
17 stolen bases in 1950; and,

18 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio was named Most Valuable Player in  
19 the American League in 1939, 1940 and 1947; and,

20 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio played in the World Series 10  
21 times, winning all but one; and,

22 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio set a major league record by  
23 hitting safely in 56 straight games; and,

24 WHEREAS, Joseph Paul DiMaggio was named to the Baseball Hall of  
25 Fame in 1955; and,


