WHEREAS, Issues such as language, cultural misunderstanding and confusion over identity make young Latinos' struggle for success particularly challenging; and

WHEREAS, El Dia de los Ninos will serve to bring attention to issues related to children including poverty, abuse, illiteracy and safety; and

WHEREAS, Families in San Francisco and across the United States should have an established day to acknowledge the contribution and value of their children; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco joins children, parents, organizations, and communities across the United States in declaring April 30 Children's Day - El Dia de los Ninos; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City of San Francisco shall send a copy of this resolution to the National Latino Children's Institute, and Governor Gray Davis.
