2 APPOINTING ONE MEMBER TO THE DELINQUENCY PREVENTION COMMISSION;  
3 WAIVING RESIDENCY.

5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
6 of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated  
7 person to serve as member of the Delinquency Prevention Commission,  
8 pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco Administrative Code  
9 Section 20.51, for the term specified:

11 Julie Posadas, succeeding Mary Midgett, (Seat No. 10, Must be  
12 the nominee of Supervisor Brown,) for the unexpired portion of four-  
13 year term ending December 31,2000.

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the  
16 following findings:

17 1. The membership of the Delinquency Prevention Commission has a  
18 goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and  
19 County of San Francisco.

20 2. Applicant Julie Posadas, a new appointee, who is not a  
21 resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that  
22 uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Delinquency Prevention  
23 Commission.

24 3. The Delinquency Prevention Commission has attempted to fill  
25 the position, for which Julie Posadas was nominated, with an

1 individual who is a City resident and who has the specific  
2 experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable  
3 to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified  
4 that Julie Posadas is qualified to serve on the Delinquency  
5 Prevention Commission.

6 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors  
7 concludes that there is no other possible representative, who  
8 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific  
9 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this  
10 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Delinquency  
11 Prevention Commission at this time; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the  
13 residency requirement for Julie Posadas, as allowed in cases where no  
14 qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to  
15 Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires individuals appointed  
16 to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by  
17 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be residents of the  
18 City and County of San Francisco.




