FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Delinquency Prevention Commission has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Julie Posadas, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies her to serve on the Delinquency Prevention Commission.
- 3. The Delinquency Prevention Commission has attempted to fill the position, for which Julie Posadas was nominated, with an

individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Julie Posadas is qualified to serve on the Delinquency Prevention Commission.

4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Delinquency Prevention Commission at this time; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Julie Posadas, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires individuals appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be residents of the City and County of San Francisco.
