

Resolution Approving a California Cultural and Historical Endowment (CCHE) Grant and Authorizing the Executive Officer to Process the Approved Grant for

San Francisco Recreation and Park Department: Palace of Fine Arts, Phase IIC, Historical Landscape and Park Improvements

WHEREAS, the CCHE is dedicated to preserving historical and cultural resources; and

WHEREAS, CCHE has received an appropriation from Proposition 40, California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002; and

WHEREAS, CCHE may distribute funds from Proposition 40 to projects that provide a thread of California's cultural and historical resources; and

WHEREAS, the Project listed above meets the objectives of the CCHE program; and

WHEREAS, approval of this grant shall be conditioned upon the grantee's compliance with all applicable laws and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of demolition of asphalt walkways, benches and footings; tree removal; pedestrian and rotunda paving; colonnade vault lighting; and installation of wayfinding podiums, interpretive displays, catch basins and lagoon edge treatment; and

WHEREAS, the CCHE Board reserved the Project's funding on April 14, 2010, to allow the Project to come back to the Board for potential approval in the future; and

WHEREAS, CCHE has independently reviewed the Project and finds that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301, Class 1, Existing Facilities; Section 15304, Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; and Section 15331, Class 31, Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation, of the CEQA Guidelines. The Project consists of the restoration of the historic western landscaping; replacement Rotunda floor, pathways and western Lagoon edge; and installation of interpretation elements in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the CCHE Board approves funding for the Project in the amount of \$500,000; authorizes the Executive Officer, or designee, to process the approved grant and take all necessary actions to enter into a Grant Agreement with the applicant, subject to availability of appropriated funds; and
