[AC Transit Transbay Bus Service]

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, THE METROPOLITAN  
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (MTC), AND CALTRANS TO WORK  
COOPERATIVELY TO RETAIN AC TRANSIT BUS SERVICE AT THE CURRENT  
TRANSBAY TERMINAL SITE

WHEREAS, AC Transit regional bus service is currently located at the Transbay  
Terminal site; and,

WHEREAS, AC Transit ridership has increased to approximately 14,000  
passengers per day since the 1997 BART strike; and,

WHEREAS, With the recent passage of Proposition I, voters clearly showed their  
preference for a strong regional intermodal transit system; and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Proposition I, the City and County of San Francisco  
requests that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and CALTRANS  
include passenger rail service as part of the redesign of the Bay Bridge, in order to reduce  
regional traffic congestion and promote regional mass transit use; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County's stated commitment to high speed rail,  
passenger rail on the Bay Bridge, and extended Caltrain service makes the current  
Transbay Terminal site the ideal location for a regional intermodal passenger hub in San  
Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, AC Transit bus service is an essential component of this proposed  
SUPERVISORS KATZ, AMMIANO, YAKI, BIERMAN, BROWN, LENO, YEE , MEDINA, BECERRIL

1 Transbay Terminal renovation; and,

2 WHEREAS, The AC Transit Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 984B  
3 supporting the retention of AC Transit Transbay bus service at a mixed-use, multi-modal  
4 transit center in downtown San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That Resolution #448-97, which endorsed the Main/Beale South  
6 Design Concept and Program as the preferred alternative for a replacement facility for the  
7 Transbay Transit Terminal, is hereby repealed; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the  
9 City and County of San Francisco to work expeditiously with AC Transit, the  
10 Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and CALTRANS to retain AC Transit  
11 regional bus service at the current Transbay Terminal site; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That every effort should be made to maintain the  
13 current level of AC Transit bus service and operational efficiency during the planning,  
14 construction, and operation of a new or rebuilt Transbay Terminal.




