

1 [Expend DOC Beverage Container Recycling Payment]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to expend a \$230,484 payment from the**
4 **Department of Conservation (DOC) for Fiscal Year 2000/2001.**

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6 WHEREAS, Recycling conserves resources and is necessary to achieve the state
7 mandated goal of 50% waste diversion; and,

8 WHEREAS, The City established the Solid Waste Management Program, which
9 manages the Curbside Program and other beverage container recycling programs; and,

10 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 14581 (a) (4) (A) of the California Public Resources
11 Code, the DOC is required to make annual payments to eligible cities and counties that
12 submit the necessary forms; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is authorized to expend a \$230,484 beverage
14 container recycling payment; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Solid Waste Management Program Director is
16 hereby authorized and empowered to execute all necessary forms for purposes of securing
17 payments and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in Section 14581 (a) (4) (A)
18 of the California Public Resources Code; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives indirect costs as
20 they are not allowed.
