Attached, please find an original and two single-sided, black and white copies of a proposed resolution for Board of Supervisors approval that would adopt the San Francisco Behavioral Health Services Act (B/MHSA) FY2025-2026 Annual Update.

The Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) was passed in 2004 through a ballot initiative (Proposition 63) and provided funding to support new and expanded county mental health programs. In March 2024, California voters passed Proposition 1, a two-bill package that includes the BHSA and Behavioral Health Infrastructure Bond Act of 2024. As we are in a transitional phase of moving from MHSA to BHSA, B/MHSA is noted throughout the annual report. San Francisco's B/MHSA FY2025-2026 Annual Update was developed with stakeholder input, posted for 30-day public comment, and heard at a Public Hearing at the San Francisco Behavioral Health Commission, as required by the State to access MHSA funding. State legislation, AB 1467, also requires adoption of the Annual Update by the County Board of Supervisors prior to submission to the State Mental Health Services and Oversight Accountability Commission.
