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7	WHEREAS, ROOTS is a program of Community Works funded by the National
8	Institute of Corrections and a collaboration with the Sheriff's Department and Visitacion Valley
9	Middle School; and,
10	WHEREAS, ROOTS is an innovative, community-designed effort that provides positive
11	experience for the children of incarcerated parents, to reduce levels of trauma and
12	stigmatization for the child both personally and socially, and to address specific issues that
13	children of incarcerated parents face; and
14	WHEREAS, ROOTS accomplishes these objectives through a coordinated program of
15	in-school therapeutic intervention for children support services for custodial parents or
16	guardians, an expressive arts after-school program and bi-annual field trips; and,
17	WHEREAS, ROOTS promotes the resiliency of children of incarcerated parents by
18	providing a full-time social worker, Case Manager, Licensed Therapist, and a part time MFCC
	Therapist at Visitacion Valley Middle School; and,
19	WHEREAS, The success of ROOTS is evident in the 45 families the program serve in
20	Visitacion Valley, where social and behavioral problems of these youth have dropped
21	drastically since its implementation; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors extends
23	their highest recommendation to ROOTS for their efforts to provide children of incarcerated
24	and highest recommendation to record for their entries to provide emiliation of incarcerated
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1	parents in Visitacion Valley with a comprehensive, community based program to meet their
2	special needs.
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
