4	all applications submitted by the City for federal, State, or other grants requesting
5	funding for fifty thousand dollars or more for any project or program shall be subject to
6	approval by the Board of Supervisors by resolution and placed on the For Adoption
7	Without Committee Reference portion of the Board of Supervisors' Agenda.

11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
13	Section 10.170, to read as follows:
14	Sec. 10.170. Grant – Application Procedure.
15	Applications for federal, State, or other grants involving requesting funding for less than
16	fifty thousand dollars for any project or program shall be filed on behalf of a department upon
17	the approval by the department head.
18	Applications for federal, State, or other grants requesting funding for fifty thousand dollars or
19	more for any project or program is subject to the approval by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
20	The request for approval of a grant application must include, and shall be processed, in the following
21	<u>manner:</u>
22	(a) A proposed resolution approving the grant application signed by the department head
23	and the Mayor or his or her designee;
24	(b) A completed "Grant Application Information Form" provided by the Clerk of the Board
25	indicating the grant sought, the funding agency including contact information, applicable deadlines,

1	details of the grant, and the purpose(s) for which the grant will be utilized. Contact information shall
2	include a name, address, telephone number, and website address for the funding agency;
3	(c) The resolution shall be introduced and placed on the For Adoption Without Committee
4	Reference portion of the Agenda for the next available meeting of the Board of Supervisors;
5	(d) If any Supervisor requests that such a resolution be referred to a committee, the
6	resolution shall be submitted to a committee and reviewed by the Budget Analyst;
7	(e) When approval of a grant application must be granted within two weeks in order for the
8	application to be timely submitted, the department may submit the grant application and retroactively
9	apply to the Board for approval. The retroactive approval process shall be as follows:
10	(1) The department shall submit a proposed resolution approving the grant application
11	signed by the department head and the Mayor or his or her designee, a completed "Grant Application
12	Information Form", and a cover letter indicating the necessity and reason for retroactive approval to
13	the Clerk's Office for the Board of Supervisors;
14	(2) The resolution shall be introduced and placed on the For Adoption Without Committee
15	Reference portion of the Agenda for the next available meeting of the Board of Supervisors;
16	(3) If any Supervisor requests that the resolution be referred to a committee, the resolution
17	shall be submitted to a committee and reviewed by the Budget Analyst.
