

1 [Settlement of Lawsuit - Monte Stott - \$188,300]

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3 **Ordinance authorizing partial settlement of the lawsuit filed by Monte Stott against the**
4 **City and County of San Francisco for \$188,300; the lawsuit was filed on August 20,**
5 **2015, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492; entitled David Alfaro,**
6 **et al. v. City and County of San Francisco; the lawsuit involves inverse condemnation**
7 **arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms in December of 2014; this**
8 **settlement relates only to the diminution of real property value claims of plaintiff Monte**
9 **Stott, and does not include claims for property loss or for attorney's fees, costs and**
10 **interest.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
14 authorizes the City Attorney to settle in part, and only as to plaintiff Monte Stott, the action
15 entitled David Alfaro, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, San Francisco Superior
16 Court, Case No. CGC-15-547492 by the payment of \$188,300 to plaintiff Monte Stott. The
17 lawsuit involves inverse condemnation arising out of flooding damage during major rainstorms
18 in December of 2014.

19 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on
20 August 20, 2015. This is an action brought by owners or occupants of several dozen
21 properties located in San Francisco against defendant City and County of San Francisco.

22 Section 3. This is a partial settlement of the action. It resolves the diminution of real
23 property value claims of commercial property owning plaintiff Monte Stott. The parties will
24 subsequently and separately address all claims for statutory attorney's fees relating to this
25 action.
