

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency, Department of Parking**
4 **and Traffic to apply for, accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$324,000 from the**
5 **California Department of Transportation Hazard Elimination Safety grant program to**
6 **install Pedestrian Countdown Signals at up to 30 various intersection locations**
7 **throughout the City for Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements.**

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9 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation’s Hazard Elimination Safety
10 (HES) Program provides federal funds for safety improvements on public roads and,

11 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation solicits candidate HES
12 projects from local agencies on an annual basis; and

13 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco Department of Parking and Traffic
14 (DPT) submitted a proposal for funding to install Pedestrian Countdown Signals at up to 30
15 various intersection locations throughout the City for Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements,
16 requesting \$324,000 from the California Department of Transportation’s Hazard Elimination
17 Safety grant program with a required local match of \$36,000 from Prop K Sales Tax Funds;
18 and,

19 WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation advises the City and County
20 of San Francisco that funding for the Pedestrian Countdown Signals Project has been
21 approved; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Director of
25 Transportation or his Designee to apply for, accept and expend up to \$324,000 from the

1 California Department of Transportation's Hazard Elimination Safety grant program with a
2 required local match of \$36,000 from Prop K Sales Tax Funds, to install Pedestrian
3 Countdown Signals at up to 30 various intersection locations throughout the City; and be it
4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
5 indirect costs in the grant budget.
