2 URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO SEND A UNANIMOUS  
3 LETTER TO UNITED STATES SENATOR DIANNE FEINSTEIN URGING HER TO  
4 SUPPORT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES IN A FAIR AND SPEEDY  
5 RESOLUTION OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE IMPEACHMENT TRIAL AND TO  
6 REACH A CONSENSUS THAT WILL ENABLE PUBLIC OFFICIALS TO RESUME THEIR  
7 FOCUS ON PROVIDING LEADERSHIP AND ADDRESSING MAJOR ISSUES THAT DEAL  
8 WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN THE UNITED STATES AND  
9 ESTABLISHING PEACE AND JUSTICE ABROAD.

10 WHEREAS, President William Jefferson Clinton has issued a public apology for his  
11 conduct and expressed his sincere desire for the United States Senate to handle the impeachment  
12 trial expeditiously; and,

13 WHEREAS, Citizens of the United States have consistently and overwhelmingly  
14 expressed to the United States Senate their wish that the impeachment matter involving  
15 President Clinton is resolved with all deliberate speed; and,

16 WHEREAS, The majority of the Democratic members of the Senate are working  
17 diligently to ensure that the Senate impeachment trial is finalized quickly but conducted fairly;  
18 and,

19 WHEREAS, Senator Dianne Feinstein represents the citizens of the State of California  
20 and thus will be able to exercise influence in the handling of matters facing the Senate regarding  
21 the impeachment trial of President Clinton; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors is hereby urged to send a  
24 unanimous letter to United States Senator Dianne Feinstein urging her to support the President of  
25 the United States in a fair and speedy resolution of the United States Senate impeachment trial  
Supervisors Brown, Teng, Bierman

and to reach a consensus that will enable public officials to resume their focus on providing leadership and addressing major issues that deal with the improvement of the quality of life in the United States and establishing peace and justice abroad.




