WHEREAS, Violence against women, children, the elderly and intimate partners are serious, widespread social problems in America; and,

WHEREAS, Estimates range from 960,000 incidents of violence against a current or former spouse, boyfriend or girlfriend per year to 3.9 million women who are physically abused by their husbands or live-in partners per year nationwide; and,

WHEREAS, About half of all female victims of intimate violence report an injury of some type, and about 20 percent of them seek medical assistance; and,

WHEREAS, Women seek medical attention for injuries sustained as a consequence of domestic violence-significantly more often after separation than during cohabitation; and,

WHEREAS, In 1998, five out of 11 (45%) solved female homicide

cases in San Francisco were domestic violence related; and,

WHEREAS, Domestic elder abuse estimates range from 500,000 to 2.5 million cases per year nationwide; and,

WHEREAS, In a national survey of more than 2,000 American families, approximately 50 percent of the men who frequently assault their wives also frequently abuse their children; and,

WHEREAS, According to a report by the National Coalition of Anti-Violence Programs, violence in same sex relationships occurs at the same rate as in heterosexual ones; and,

WHEREAS, It is the intent of the City and County of San Francisco to ensure the well-being of all victims of violence; and

WHEREAS, ADT Services, Inc., a private corporation, has developed the AWARE program that places security systems and emergency necklace pendants in the residences of battered or abused victims; and,

WHEREAS, Victims who participate in the AWARE program have the ability to alert law enforcement with a silent alarm by pressing the emergency necklace pendant when they feel in imminent danger of attack; and,

WHEREAS, ADT is generously providing the City and County of San Francisco with security systems, pendants and system monitoring free of charge; and,

WHEREAS, Key representatives from San Francisco's law enforcement and domestic violence advocacy and service agencies have come together to develop the specifications and implementation plan for an AWARE program here; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco announces the establishment of the AWARE program in the City and County of San Francisco; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses the establishment of the AWARE

program in the City and County of San Francisco as a tool to further the City's objective of ensuring the well-being and safety of women, children, the elderly and intimate partners who are victims of violence.
