15	respondents in this study; and,		
16	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires the City to enter into a		
17	Vendor Contract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
18	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as		
19	if set forth fully herein; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The terms of the agreement prohibit including indirect costs in the contract		
21	budget; now, therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a Vendor		
23	Contract agreement in the amount of \$23,566 with UCSF, for services under the California		
23	HIV Incident Study; and, be it
