3	Resolution affirming the City and County of San Francisco's support for immigrant and
4	human rights in the face of growing border vigilantism.
5	
6	WHEREAS, One out of every four Californians is an immigrant, including 37% of San
7	Francisco residents; and,
8	WHEREAS, San Francisco has a long and rich history of welcoming immigrants and
9	refugees, facilitating their inclusion into our communities, and encouraging their integration to
10	ensure that our city is a rich and diverse community; and,
11	WHEREAS, There has been a growth of vigilante groups such as the Minutemen, a
12	group that has patrolled the Mexico/Arizona border and has expanded its operations into
13	California, Texas, Washington, Idaho, Montana, and North Dakota; and,
14	WHEREAS, Vigilante groups do not help with border security but, in fact, make it more
15	difficult for the border patrol to do its job; and,
16	WHEREAS, Vigilante groups create a more dangerous and hostile environment for all
17	border communities and immigrants who come here seeking work and a better life for
18	themselves and their families; and,
19	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has taken a strong stand against
20	hate violence and organizations that promote such acts of violence; and,
21	WHEREAS, As our nation struggles with a sense of vulnerability and insecurity, many
22	state and national leaders are failing to support our immigrant communities by remaining
23	silent in the face of increasing anti-immigrant rhetoric and activity; now, therefore, be it
24	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco affirms its commitment to
25	supporting immigrants and human rights in the face of growing vigilantism; and,

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco calls upon
2	local, state, and national leaders to protect immigrants and others from vigilante violence, to
3	prosecute the perpetrators of vigilante violence, and to make immigration reform that
4	addresses the root causes of migration and upholds the rights of all residents regardless of
5	immigration status as a top priority.
