WHEREAS, the SFRRC trained hundreds of San Francisco and Bay Area runners to compete in and finish numerous local races and marathons; and

WHEREAS, the SFRRC showcased the City to runners from all over the United States during the RRCA 2009 National Convention as host club; and

WHEREAS, the SFRRC helps beginning runners achieve their fitness goals through Running 101; and

WHEREAS, Runner's World named San Francisco as the Best Running City of 2005 in part due to clubs such as the San Francisco Road Runners Club; and
