

[Temporary Sidewalk Closure - Dreamforce 2025 on Both Sides of Howard Street Between 3rd Street and 4th Street]

Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of the public sidewalk on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October 11 through October 17, 2025, subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event.

WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Article 6 provides for the temporary use and occupancy of a public street for events receiving a permit from the Interdepartmental Staff Committee on Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT); and

WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Section 6.7 provides that the temporary use or occupancy of a public street shall not unnecessarily obstruct or bar public access onto said street, and that sidewalks shall remain open at all times for pedestrian use unless closure of the sidewalk is provided for by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors explaining the reason for such closure; and

WHEREAS, Dreamforce is an annual event sponsored by Salesforce, taking place in the City since 2003; and

WHEREAS, Dreamforce brings tens of thousands of visitors to the City each year and takes place at the Moscone Center and surrounding streets over four days; and

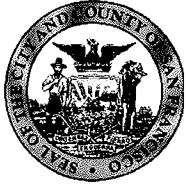
WHEREAS, Dreamforce has signed agreements to hold the annual event at the Moscone Center for 2025; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October 11th through October 17, 2025, is necessary to facilitate the event each year; and

WHEREAS, Authorization for the temporary closure of the above sidewalks is subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for each year's event; and

1 WHEREAS, This Resolution is not a stand-alone authorization to close the subject
2 sidewalks; any such closures are subject to ISCOTT approving an event permit for each
3 year's Dreamforce event that authorizes closure of the subject sidewalks and is subject to the
4 City's discretionary adoption of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings for the
5 project, following review and consideration of completed project related environmental
6 analysis, where required; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the temporary closure of the
8 sidewalks on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from October
9 11th through October 17, 2025, subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event.

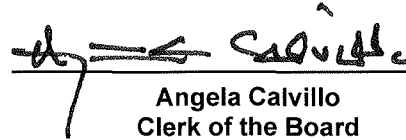
