Annual Report on Cash and In-Kind Grants received from the

San Francisco Parks Alliance for Let's Play SF!

Background

Let's Play SF! is a public-private partnership between the Recreation and Parks Department and the San Francisco Parks Alliance to renovate the 13 most deserving playgrounds in San Francisco as determined by a citizen's task force appointed by the Recreation and Parks Commission.

On February 1, 2018 by Resolution No. 10-18 the Board of Supervisors authorized the Department to accept and expend up to \$15 million in cash and in-kind grants from the Parks Alliance as part of the campaign. The resolution also required an annual report on the cash and in-kind grants.

As of February 2019, construction is complete on the playground at Washington Square Park. Construction is expected to begin at five more sites by spring 2019.
