1 [Federal Funding – Emergency Shelter Grant ]

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3 **Resolution approving the 2002 Emergency Shelter Grants Program and Expenditure**  
4 **Schedule; and authorizing the Mayor on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco**  
5 **to accept, and expend a \$879,000 entitlement under the Emergency Shelter Grants**  
6 **Program from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.**

8 WHEREAS, Under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and Cranston-  
9 Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990, the Secretary of the U.S. Department of  
10 Housing and Urban Development is authorized to make a grant to San Francisco under the  
11 Emergency Shelter Grants Program. The grant may be used for the rehabilitation or conversion  
12 of buildings for use as emergency shelters for the homeless, for the payment of certain operating  
13 and social services expenses in connection with emergency shelters, and for homeless  
14 prevention; and

15 WHEREAS, The Mayor will be able to use the grant monies to improve the operation of  
16 existing emergency shelters and thereby enhance the very basic living standards of homeless  
17 persons in the City; and;

18 WHEREAS, The grant monies will be devoted to provision of essential services for the  
19 shelters, payments for operating the shelters, and homeless prevention; and

20 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared an Expenditure  
21 Schedule designating the use of the \$879,000 Entitlement; and

22 WHEREAS, A Preliminary Environmental Record has been prepared on the proposed

1           WHEREAS, It has been determined that no environmental evaluation is required to  
2 accept and expend the City's 2002 Emergency Shelter Grants Program (ESGP) entitlement;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, The Certifying Officer shall follow procedural provisions of NEPA to make  
5 certain that all projects are in compliance with the applicable federal provisions and  
6 requirements; and

7           WHEREAS, Indirect costs have been allocated in the 2002 Community Development  
8 Block Grant (CDBG) Program to cover both CDBG and ESGP; now, therefore be it

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10           RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Office of Community Development is hereby authorized to  
11 apply for, accept, and expend a grant of \$879,000 from the U.S. Department of Housing and  
12 Urban Development under the Emergency Shelter Grants Program; and, be it

13           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the  
14 Expenditure Schedule for recipient agencies; and, be it

15           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation  
16 and certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
