15	children, she serves as a board member of "The Friends of Faith", a non-profit organization
16	dedicated to breast cancer awareness and prevention, and finding a cure; and,
17	WHEREAS, Renel has received numerous awards such as the Women of Excellence
18	award, Pioneer Achievement Award from the National Coalition of 100 Black Women of the
19	Bay Area, the Women's Inspiration Award from Girls, Inc. of Alameda, the Profiles in
20	Excellence Award for KGO-TV and etc.; now, therefore, be it
